

LIST OF POTENTIAL EXPENSES BASED ON A TEAM OF 10 RIDERS

Fuel

- Gaborone – Mazabuka Zambia 2700
- Gaborone – Windhoek Namibia 2300
- Gaborone – Tuli Block Botswana 600
- Gaborone – Harare Zimbabwe 2400
- TOTAL there and back. **8000 kms**

Distance by what vehicles we use and cost of fuel = **P10, 000 x 3 vehicles = P30, 000.**

Accommodation

- Zambian event requires 4 nights accommodation
- Namibian event requires 3 nights accommodation
- Botswana event requires 2 nights accommodation
- Zimbabwe event requires 4 nights accommodation
- TOTAL NIGHTS ACCOMMODATION NEEDED **14 nights**

Multiply number of nights needed by number in team @ P150.00 per person = **P21, 000**

Racing Fuel

Cost of racing fuel will be approximately P1000.00 per rider for the year = **P10,000**

Entry Fees

Was normally \$20.00 but allow for \$30.00 x 10 riders x 4 events = **\$1200 or P9, 000**

(Just check my maths on this!)

AMU Licences

AMU licences are sold at \$30.00 a competitor x 10 riders = **\$300 or P2250.00**

Soft Drinks/Food

Maybe we put in personally into a kitty P100 for each day we are away = P400 each for 4 days etc and buy drinks and food with this? We can then buy waters and soft drinks for road and on race day and bacon/egg rolls etc. Might even be some left over for the bar that night!

Team Clothing

I reckon we need to have made

- 30 race shirts (then we have some spare if they get torn)
- 15 – 20 pit shirts
- 50 caps
- 30 Golf Shirts

Maybe make a few more and sell them to fund the team!! **LJ to cost this.**

Miscellaneous Expenses

- \$40.00 (return) per vehicle for crossing into Zambia
- Insurance in Zambia, Zimbabwe and Namibia

Would think we would need approximately **\$300 or P2250.00**

Approximate costings so far are about P75,000 for 10 riders for the year and covers everything except your MSA licence and insurance and bike repairs.

DATES OF EVENTS AND WHEREABOUTS

January/February

- Join the club and get letter of membership confirmation from Ivorene (72249721)
- Get an MSA National licence and insurance. You will need to apply for the extended insurance (R250, 000), this is to evacuate you out of strange countries!
- Once you have MSA licence and insurance – contact me or Jacqui Monteiro of MSA to apply for your AMU licence. I will be at MSA on 11 March so can collect them all then.

March 24

- Sac event in Zambia (probably Mazabuka)

April 7 & 8 (Easter)

- This is **NOT** a Sac event, but there is mx and Enduro on and is possibly a good idea as I think they may use the same venue for the Sac/AMU event later.

May 12

- Sac event in Namibia – it is also the AMU event and if the off road commission do not put a team forward from SA, and then we might end up representing South Africa. If so, then some funding could be made available.

September 8

- Sac event in Botswana. Will be in Tuli Block.

October 20 (this is subject to change to either Dec or 6 October)

- Sac event and final prize giving in Zimbabwe. (Actual location not known).
