

Dear Clubs and Committee

Please find attached the 2007 MSA Competition Licence and Medical Forms as well as the Officials renewal/insurance and CofC and Stewards renewal forms and the 2007 One Event Licence Form (note, the Indemnity Form must also be completed with the One Event licence Form). NOTE: There are no Club One Event Licences for 2007.

Also attached are the Application Forms for 2007 Competition Numbers for Off Road Motorcycles & Quads (Adults) and 2007 Competition Numbers for Juniors.

Please note the following regarding the 2007 MSA Competition Licences:

#### Club Licences

1. Club Competitors are not required to undergo a medical examination.
2. Club Competitors must complete and sign the following forms: Licence Form, Indemnity Form, Personal Medical Certificate (page 1 of the medical).
3. Club Competitors are required to take out the MSA Personal Accident Cover if they cannot produce a letter from their Medical Aid stating that they are covered for injuries sustained in Motorsport events. No Hospital Plans acceptable, no letters from Brokers acceptable. Club licence holders (Adult) have the option of taking Option D for R200.00, giving cover of R50,000.00 medical and R25,000.00 disablement.
4. **A copy of I.D. is required from adults and a copy of Birth Certificate is required for under-age competitors, as well as proof of Club Membership for 2007.**

#### Regional Licences

1. Regional Competitors are required to undergo a medical examination.
2. Regional Competitors must complete and sign the following forms: Licence Form, Indemnity Form, Personal Medical Certificate, doctor to complete, sign and stamp page two of the Medical Certificate.
3. Regional Competitors are required to take out the MSA Personal Accident cover if they cannot produce a letter from their Medical Aid stating that they are covered for injuries sustained in Motorsport events. No Hospital; Plans accepted, no letters from Brokers accepted.
4. As per point 4 above.

#### National Licences

1. As per point 1. above
2. As per point 2. above, including the WADA (Anti Doping) Form.
3. As per point 3. above.
4. As per point 4. above.

#### Licencing, General

- \* Junior Motocross \_ the SAJMX Levy is still payable @ R100.00
- \* Oval Competitors \_ It will be Compulsory for all Oval Competitors to take out the minimum of Option D Personal Accident Cover.
- \* Oval Quad Licences \_ will have to take out the Option A Personal Accident Cover. Option D is not available to them.
- \* Super Licence is not available in 2007, for cross\_riding.
- \* Motocross Numbers \_ will be issued by Carmen Petzer at MSA Head Office \_ 011 4662440
- \* Off Road Motorcycle & Quad Numbers \_ Regional & National will be issued by Sue Le Roux, 0865120295 (fax), upon receipt of the relevant Application Form (attached), once the licence has been issued. Sue will also be issuing numbers for the Junior Off Road/Cadet

Harescrambles. KZN Club Licence holders will obtain their bike/quad numbers from Louise Trethewey on 033 5031386 or 0866161710 (fax), using the same Application Form.

\* Please ensure that these Application Forms are fully completed.

\* Off Road Motorcycle & Quad Licences: PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

\* Competitors taking out a National Off Road Competition Licence for the first time and who are 16/17 years old as at the 1st January 2007, will be restricted to either the 125cc Class or 200cc Class for Motorcycles and the 450cc Class for Quads.

\* Competitors taking out a National Off Road Motorcycle or Quad Licence for the first time and are 18 years or older \_ there is no restriction on either class or capacity of machine.

\* Competitors who are 16/17 years old as at 1st January 2007 and held a National Competiton Licence in 2006 will not be affected by the above ruling.

PLEASE NOTE THAT UNTIL THE 2007 MSA HANDBOOKS AND REGULATIONS ARE AVAILABLE, MSA COMPETITION LICENCES WILL NOT BE SOLD.

I will send out a circular once we are up and running for 2007 licencing.

Dear Club Secretaries

Please would you be kind enough to notify your competitors that should they arrive at the MSA Offices without the necessary documentation for their 2007 licence applications, the licence will not be issued. No exceptions.

Dear Clubs

Please ensure that your competitors are aware of the following:

If they are competing in a class in your category that has Club or Non\_Championship status then they will apply for a Club Licence.

If they are competing in a class in your category that has Regional Championship status then they will apply for a Regional Championship Licence.

If they are competing in a National Championship series, then they will require a full National Licence.

If they are competing in a National non\_championship class ie, a Series or Trophy Challenge, then they will apply for the National Challenge licence in their category.

Should the competitor wish to change from a Club class to a Regional or National Class, then he/she will have to up\_grade their licences.

Dear All

I have just been advised by MSA Head Office that Personal Accident Cover is not compulsory for 2007 Club Licence holders, but is highly recommended. They have the option of taking a cheaper cover @ R200.00 for R50,000.00 medical and R25,000.00 disability cover.

Yes, a copy of Birth Certificate is required for junior competitors if they do not have I.D.

No, a copy of school report is not required for 2007.
