Enduro Team

In 2007, an off road Enduro series is taking place between four Southern African countries, Namibia, Zambia, Zimbabwe and Botswana (under the auspices of Motorsport South Africa). This series is known as the Southern African Challenge (SAC), and has been put together to promote motorsport, friendship and business opportunities between the countries. One of the events, held in Namibia will also be the African Motorcycle Union Championship (involving riders from Morocco, Tunisia, Algeria, Kenya, Uganda as well as the Southern African countries), which is the Continental Championship of Africa.

Several members of the Gaborone Motor Club have shown interest in taking part in this event, and have come together to form a team. The team will probably comprise of 10 riders (although 16 people have expressed interest) who will participate in this series.

Obviously the costs involved of taking 10 riders, their bikes and equipment, to 4 countries traveling a distance of approximately 8000 kms in a year is somewhat prohibitive to the team. However, their enthusiasm for getting this team together is to be commended and any assistance you or your company can provide will be gratefully received.

Costs which the team will incur will be their AMU licences, entry fees, race fuel, accommodation and diesel for the vehicles, as well as border expenses etc. The team wants to look professional so are in the process of having caps, golf shirts, pit shirts and racing shirts made, so that they are easily identifiable.

For the company that wishes to support this team, they are more than happy to put stickers on the bikes, trailers and vehicles. Also your company logo will be put on the Pit Shirts and Race shirts. Publicity for your company will be in the form of newspaper coverage, and TV coverage. The Namibian events are normally televised. We are also hoping that Rapid Motion or Two Wheels will come to Botswana to cover the event here. After each event, the team undertakes to inform you in writing as to how the individual riders fared and to give you the results.

Any form of sponsorship that the team can raise, will be put into the Gaborone Motor Club account and utilized for the team only. If there are any monies left over at the end of the series, it will be donated to the Gaborone Motor Club.
